Way of the World constructs a dramatic theatrical environment connecting what appears to be the swashbuckling 18th century with the blight of post-apocalyptic times, reflecting harsh realities. This fantastical universe depicts the interaction between the hard-working Greys, struggling to survive in a harsh environment, and the Reds, who are fancifully situated in leisure, with its high-stationed luxuries in goods and costumes. The figures swagger or skulk across their given stage, leaving the viewer to construct relationships and explore related moral conundrums. The Reds preen, enjoying life's finest, while the Grevs are occupied with the banality of daily drudgery. Revolutions echo down the years, philosophers extol the dignity of work, everybody wants riches and leisure. The exhibition asks: who's on top?
